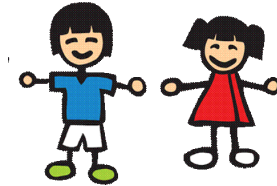

Curriculum

The curriculum is Christian-based with a thematic approach to fun and learning. The children will enjoy activities that encompass all area of development—crafts, stories, music, games, and free-play they will also be introduced to colors, shapes, letters, numbers, calendars etc. Children will have fun while developing their social, physical, cognitive and emotional development.

Christian Approach

The Parent's Day Out is sponsored by Friendship United Methodist Church and is a Christian-based program. We strongly advocate and support the Christian values of sharing, caring and loving.

We believe strongly in strengthening the self-esteem of the child and teaching respect for others.

The Christian aspect of our program is visible daily in our simple prayers and songs. Children are instructed that God created them, and they are important and unique because of a loving God.

Big Kids Room

This area is tailored to children ages 3 through 5 years old, who don't yet qualify for Kindergarten.

Allowing them a chance to develop physical, social, emotional and cognitive skills through a variety of activities like story time, calendar, crafts, play and much more.

Nursery

This learning area is for children ages 6 weeks through 2 years old. Children learn to explore their surroundings through their senses in a safe, loving, and caring environment.

Snacks & Lunch

There is a sign up for parents to bring in snacks & juice to share. We ask that you bring healthy snacks and 100% juice or milk.

On special days such as birthdays, treats like cupcakes or cookies may be shared.

The children are to bring a bagged lunch each day including a beverage. Please do not send things that need to be heated or refrigerator. A freezer pack tucked inside the lunchbox will keep cheese & yogurt fresh.

Purpose

Our purpose is twofold..

Parents choosing to "stay home" may find the job difficult and their hours long. As much as we love our children, 24 hours a day, seven days a week can be stressful.

Parents deserve and need some time away from their children to shop, read, make an appointment or to clean house!

Our program provides a safe, loving and nurturing environment for your child, so that you can take a break or get things done confident that your child is having fun!

Cooperative Program

Parent's Day Out is a Christian Outreach Program sponsored by Friendship United Methodist Church.

We try to keep our costs low as possible by utilizing parent volunteers.

This is a cooperative program.

- If your child attends one day per week, then you work one day every other month.
- If your child attends two days per week, then you work one day each month.

A parent of a registered child may send a suitable adult substitute for their shift (grandparents or other relative) but they must very familiar with your child.
